Paid leave programs (Federal funded. Employer administered.)

- Paid leave programs overview
- Paid Sick Time. Additional sick time beyond employer provided leave.
 - ➤ Time off for care of a sick child or adult, compliance with quarantine isolation, etc. related to COVID-19 pandemic
 - For self-employed workers, public employees, and those employed by organizations with less than 500 employees.
 - For full time workers, 80 hours of paid sick time related to COVID-19
 - For part time workers, payment for average number of hours worked during a 2- week time period.
- **Emergency Paid Leave**. Up to a maximum of 12 weeks of leave with job protection for COVID-19 related absences.
 - For employees unable to work due to school closures for a child under 18, or unavailability of day care provider.
 - First 10 days may be unpaid, overlapping with paid sick time or employee provided leave.
 - For remaining 10 weeks, employer pays 2/3 of wage, up to a maximum of \$200 per day.
 - Job protection under Family and Medical Leave Act (FMLA).
